

The Summit highlights the importance of place as participants immerse themselves in significant institutions, including Parliament House, the National Press Club, the National Portrait Gallery and Embassies.

Leaders engage with prominent business leaders, politicians and senior public servants, diplomats, change-makers and thought-leaders, enriching their understanding of the Asia-Australia ecosystem.
