Workshop

Business & Entrepreneurship

Content

In this immersive workshop, students will engage with the key skills, knowledge, and mindsets required to succeed as entrepreneurs and future business leaders. They will explore how business ideas can respond to real-world challenges, examine local and global market needs.

- Understand the core knowledge, skills, attitudes, and values needed to become an effective entrepreneur in a global context
- Develop their voice, agency, and leadership skills to design entrepreneurial solutions to identified problems

Learning Outcomes

Students will gain:

- A stronger understanding of entrepreneurship and the attributes of successful, ethical business leaders
- Practical experience in developing a business or social enterprise idea that addresses a real community or global challenge
- Confidence in applying problem-solving, creativity, collaboration, and leadership skills in a business context

Public Speaking

In this immersive workshop, students who use English as an additional language will develop confidence and clarity in public speaking through structured scaffolding and guided practice. The workshop provides practical strategies to help students organise ideas, express themselves clearly, and present with confidence in English.

- Learn simple and effective frameworks for structuring spoken presentations
- Build confidence in using English through supported speaking activities
- Improve clarity, pronunciation, and delivery for different audiences
- Develop strategies to manage nervousness and speak with confidence

Students will gain:

- Confidence to speak up and present clearly in English, even in unfamiliar or formal settings
- Practical presentation skills they can use across subjects, assessments, and real-world situations
- The ability to communicate ideas with clarity, structure, and impact in English



Workshop

Global Citizenship

Content

In this immersive workshop, students will engage with the skills, knowledge and attributes required of global citizens. They will examine global and local issues and explore how to use voice and agency to address these.

- Understand the knowledge, skills, attitudes and values needed to be an effective global citizen.
- Build awareness of the UN Sustainable Development Goals, the targets and the action we can take to meet each one.
- Examine local and global issues and explore how to use your student voice, agency, and leadership strengths to take action.

Learning Outcomes

Students will gain:

- Enhanced understanding of the notion of global citizenship and the attributes of global citizens.
- Greater awareness of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.
- An opportunity to develop strategies to action one of the Sustainable Development Goals in their own communities.

Leadership Empowerment

In this immersive workshop, students will explore different leadership paradigms and embrace diverse approaches to effecting positive change in their communities and beyond.

- Value the significance of self awareness, empathy, and effective communication as foundational elements in honing leadership capabilities, fostering an understanding of how these skills contribute to sustainable development.
- Explore the pivotal role of youth-led initiatives, advocacy efforts, and community engagement in driving positive social, environmental, and political transformations, with a focus on aligning actions with global efforts to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals.

Students will gain:

- A more nuanced understanding of different forms of leadership.
- An enhanced understanding of how leadership skills are built and practiced.
- Inspiration to recognise their leadership potential.



Workshop

Australian Tertiary Pathways Exploration

Content

In this immersive workshop, students will engage with diverse tertiary education options in Australia. They will explore tertiary pathways that match their skills and interests and consider their possible outcomes.

- Develop the capacity to make informed decisions about tertiary education pathways by assessing personal strengths, aspirations, and opportunities for growth within diverse educational contexts.
- Gain insight into the range of tertiary institutions and educational programs available, encompassing vocational, academic and alternative routes.

Learning Outcomes

Students will gain:

- An enhanced understanding of different tertiary pathways in Australia.
- An opportunity to evaluate their skills and interests for tertiary study.
- A better ability to evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of different tertiary pathways and the outcomes that they can lead to.

Intercultural Understanding

In this immersive workshop, students will engage with intercultural communication ideas and practices. They will practice how to communicate with people from different cultural backgrounds and will unpack cultural stereotypes and biases.

- Develop empathy and respect for diverse cultures by exploring similarities and differences across societies
- Enhance cross-cultural communication skills through language-based activities and role-playing exercises
- Strengthen critical thinking by analysing cultural stereotypes, assumptions, and biases
- Cultivate an appreciation for cultural diversity through storytelling and the sharing of personal experiences

Students will gain:

- A deeper understanding of intercultural communication skills.
- The opportunity to practise communicating with people from different cultural backgrounds.
- Skills to evaluate cultural stereotypes and biases.



Workshop

Shared History - China and Australia

Content

In this immersive workshop, students will engage with the intertwined histories of China and Australia. They will explore centuries of cultural exchanges, economic integration and geo-political interactions.

- Investigate key historical events that have shaped the relationship between the two nations.
- Explore and reflect on similarities and differences between Chinese and Australian historical trajectories over time.
- Appraise examples of the positive impact of Chinese immigration on Australian society and culture.

Learning Outcomes

Students will gain:

- A greater understanding of the historical milestones, cultural exchanges and shared experiences between Australia and China.
- Insights into the contributions of Chinese Australians to various facets of Australian life.

Optional Excursion:

Museum of Chinese Australian History in Melbourne.

Climate Change & Sustainability

In this immersive workshop, students will engage with the critical concepts of climate change and sustainability. They will explore climate-related challenges relevant to Australia and their home countries.

- Investigate the impacts of climate change in Australia and reflect on parallels in their home contexts
- Examine innovative sustainability practices and initiatives implemented across Australia
- Evaluate how Australian approaches to sustainability can inform global solutions
- Strengthen critical thinking and problem-solving skills through interactive discussions and hands-on sustainability-focused activities
- Gain inspiration and practical ideas to become advocates for climate action within their own communities

Students will gain:

- A deeper understanding of climate change and its implications.
- Inspiration to engage in collective action towards a more sustainable future.
- Stronger skills in teamwork and critical thinking.
